And the Angel of the LORD spoke unto Philip again, "Arise, and go toward the south unto the way that goeth down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert" (Acts 8:26).

Evangelist Philip went to Samaria. While he was there, a revival broke out. This revival was accompanied by outstanding miracles of power. The sick were healed, demons were cast out, the glory of the LORD was manifested, and the whole city was moved and stirred by the preaching of Philip. Philip was at the height of an apostolic ministry with GOD moving through him in a mighty way. Then one night, the ANGEL of the LORD spoke to him saying, "Philip, arise and leave the revival and go down toward Gaza into the desert." I think there would be some questioning in the heart of Philip as he listened to those directions telling him to leave the revival. Leave the move of GOD? Leave the demonstration of GOD'S power and go down into the desert? There's no water there and no air-conditioning. They

don't have a McDonald's there or a Colonel Sanders. LORD, I don't like the desert; I want to stay here with the revival. This revival needs me. The power of GOD is moving, the revival is on, souls are being saved, I'm needed here!

But Philip started his journey down past Jerusalem on the highway that leads along the shore of the Mediterranean and out into North Africa. As he walked along the road he prayed, "All right, LORD, I am here. What do YOU want me to do?" As he looked up, along came one of the Cadillacs of his day—a wealthy man riding in a chariot, dressed in royal apparel. He was reading the scroll of the Prophet Isaiah as he rode along. Seeing Philip, he commanded the chariot to stop, and invited Philip to get in beside him. Philip stepped into the chariot and noticed the man was reading the scroll of the Prophet Isaiah. "Do you understand what you're reading?" he asked. (He was reading the 53<sup>rd</sup> chapter of Isaiah which speaks of the LORD JESUS CHRIST.) The eunuch

replied, "How can I understand if somebody doesn't tell me?"

GOD had sent Philip to explain this scripture to this man. The man believed, became saved, and was baptized, all on the same day. History tells us that this man was one in great authority, the treasurer of the whole land of Ethiopia, who returned to Ethiopia and brought the WORD of GOD to those people there and established a church there (the roots of which are still there today because Philip was obedient to GOD'S WORD and went down into the desert).<sup>1</sup>

Many men of GOD have been sent to the desert.<sup>2</sup> This is something that every one of us would like to avoid if it were at all possible. We find it uncomfortable when GOD cuts across our path and says to us, "I want you to go down to the desert." But in every life that GOD uses comes this desert experience. In Philip's experience, GOD had ministered to him; he was caught up in the SPIRIT and trans-

lated out of the desert over to the seacoast by the supernatural power of GOD.

The desert experience is an absolute necessity in the lives of real men and women of GOD.<sup>3</sup> HE does not choose to perfect HIS vessels in the city, but rather in the desert place. You can tell when a person is in the desert because you'll hear him say, "I feel so dry, the Heavens feel like iron, and I don't understand what is happening to me." GOD is bringing you into a desert experience. We are so interested in the ministry and in giving out, and that is good. We are so interested in the multitudes. We want to be going, but GOD is saying to us, "Son (or daughter), I want you to come aside. I want to draw you away from the crowd. I want to separate you. I want to get you alone, out here under the stars in a solitary place, where I can talk to you. I want to burn MY WORD into your eternal soul.<sup>4</sup> I want to put MY message into your mouth.<sup>5</sup> I want to get down into your innermost being. I want to do a work in you."<sup>6</sup> And this is something we are not always prepared for. We cry, "But I don't like the solitary place. I like people around me. I like people to know what I'm going through. I like people to sympathize with me. I like people to understand. I like companionship." But GOD is saying, "I'm pressing you into the desert, and if you really love ME and believe MY WORD, you'll go. I'm bringing you there because I want to meet you there, alone, in the desert."

Let's talk about this desert. I thank GOD there are streams of water. I thank GOD for mountain tops. But I also thank GOD that in the life of every man and woman who goes by the name of Christian, there is an appointment with destiny. Everyone that will ever come forth with a burning message, and every prophet that has the boldness to stand before the face of the whole nation and even the world, is the man that GOD has led to a solitary place—a desert place—a lonely place—

a place of midnight darkness—a place where there is no moisture—that is the place where GOD speaks and deals and shapes and fashions and forms.<sup>7</sup> Then GOD is able to send that man or that woman forth from that desert with life-giving Water and HIS message of eternal salvation.

When GOD called Moses, he was eighty years old. HE had allowed Moses to receive an education and to live like a prince.<sup>8</sup> For forty years, he was waited on and catered to. He bathed himself in the sparkling waters of the Nile River with servants waiting on him hand and foot. His clothes were the finest of needlework and he feasted on the royal dainties of Pharaoh's table as he learned the ways of the Egyptians. Then one day, GOD said to Moses, "Phase one of your education is over, and now I have a more important appointment to keep with you." GOD led him over onto the backside of the desert.<sup>9</sup> For forty more years he trudged up and down the sand dunes until his skin was burned with the sun and his eyes were red from the sand, until GOD had worked the solitariness of the desert into the very soul of Moses.<sup>10</sup> And now GOD was ready to keep that appointment. His life was broken up into three forty-year equal segments; forty years in Egypt, forty years on the desert, and then forty years in judgment; and he was given the law for Israel, and for the world.

Moses met a burning bush on the backside of the desert.<sup>11</sup> He heard the voice of the LORD, obeyed it, and came forth with the fire of a prophet and the glory of GOD in his soul.<sup>12</sup> He led between two and three million Israelites out of captivity, working great signs and wonders and miracles—because he had met GOD in a desert place.<sup>13</sup>

If you're going to GOD'S people with signs and wonders and miracles, and you are going to carry a rod that brings deliverance, there is also a burning bush that GOD has for you in HIS desert place, that you must first meet. Don't think that someone is going to call you out of the congregation and lay hands on you and

impart a ministry to you that is going to bring men and women out of blindness and bondage. Don't think that you are going to attend Bible school and somebody will hand you a diploma that will automatically qualify you to deliver your people. If you want to bring people out of the bondage of Egypt, then you are going to have to meet GOD on the backside of the desert. GOD will take away the pleasures. HE will take away the comforts. HE will take away the things that you've trusted in, and HE will drive you from men, in HIS SPIRIT, to a solitary place where it's just you and GOD. Every true prophet of GOD, every warrior for the LORD, anyone who ever expects to accomplish for GOD must come face to face with his Creator on the backside of the desert.

Joseph, come and testify. "I was the eleventh son of my father.<sup>14</sup> I had spiritual dreams and spiritual visions,<sup>15</sup> and I knew that I had a date with destiny; but I was one that lived in a solitary place. My father's children, my own brothers, despised me.<sup>16</sup> I lived as an outcast in my father's home.<sup>17</sup> I was the one that was sent to live in the dungeon and in the gloominess of prison."<sup>18</sup> Joseph, how can you sit as a mighty prince over the land? Did you have a desert experience? "Indeed, I met GOD'S qualifications in the dungeon of Pharaoh." Where did you learn this forgiveness and this equity? Where did you learn the compassion that you feel toward other human beings? "I learned it from crying my way through the lonely hours as I peered through the bars of Pharaoh's prison. That's where I learned the compassion of GOD."

John, how is it that you can stand with such eloquence? John, how is it that you can move this multitude to repentance? John, how did this fire and this power and this passion come into your life, that you can sway a nation with your preaching against sin? "I left my father's home as a young man and went and heeded the call of the HOLY SPIRIT, and lived in the desert.<sup>19</sup> I wore a leather girdle and ate wild honey and grasshoppers,<sup>20</sup> and I met the LORD GOD on the backside of the

desert. The WORD of GOD came to my heart, and I came out of the desert with zeal and the glory of GOD in my soul. Then and only then was I able to preach a message of repentance that could bring people to their knees.”

After Paul was converted on the Damascus road, he preached CHRIST for a time.<sup>21</sup> Then he went into the Arabian Desert for two years.<sup>22</sup> The Scriptures tell us nothing about these years, but he disappeared into the desert for two years after his conversion and lived in a lonely solitary place. Only then did he come forth as the mighty apostle of GOD.

And even YOU, LORD JESUS; YOU who have been anointed from before the foundations of the earth to bring eternal salvation to a lost and dying world.<sup>23</sup> YOU, JESUS—yes, even the LORD—where are YOU going? Are YOU going to the temple in Jerusalem to proclaim YOURSELF as the MESSIAH? “No, I am pressed in the SPIRIT to go into the wilderness for forty days.”<sup>24</sup> And in those days of continuous fasting and prayer, HE proved to Satan the power of GOD’S HOLY WORD and came forth out of the desert, full of grace and truth, to execute the mission HE was on from Heaven.<sup>25</sup> Yes, even KING JESUS did HIS time on the desert, and many more times than just then.

Every man and every woman that GOD has ever laid HIS hand upon and called, HE brings to a desert place. I’m talking about a solitary place in your spiritual life where GOD separates you, when people don’t understand you, when you know that your time has come to be used of GOD. GOD says, “I’m not going to send anyone to pray over or for you. You are going to have to do your own praying.”<sup>26</sup> You are going to meet GOD ALMIGHTY face to face. GOD will take you out to that desert place where you will either come to grips with your walk with GOD or you will die. You will lie on your face before GOD and cry out in agony until you find that rightful place in GOD. You’ll find a new relationship with GOD, and you’ll never care again when GOD tells you to

go to Nineveh, because you’ve plugged into the throne of GOD yourself, and HIS glory is before your face constantly. I’m talking about a place where GOD instructs you, and you receive HIS instruction. It’s a place where there is no human comfort for you, and where nobody understands what you are doing.

What do you think David was going through when he had six hundred men around him and not one of them understood him? He said, “My soul is thirsting for life; GOD, where have YOU gone? I can’t feel YOU. My soul thirsteth for the living GOD.”<sup>27</sup> David was in a place where GOD wasn’t coming to him and speaking to him, and he had to stand on the WORD of GOD that was working within him. He had to have faith in the goodness and the mercy of the LORD, that GOD would somehow carry him through this trial and spiritual desert.<sup>28</sup>

GOD is trying to grow some men and women up. You say, “GOD called me to prophesy.” Oh, HE did, did HE? First let me see the sand in your shoes. When the prophets of old came with the WORD of the LORD, some of them were stoned, some thrown in jails, and others ostracized and even killed.<sup>29</sup> And here you are, the first time you suffer a little persecution, you cry and say, “I’m going to backslide.” But if you let HIM and yield to HIS SPIRIT, GOD will perfect you in that desert place and mature you.

There will come a time in your experience when GOD shuts people out and shuts you in with HIM, and you cry, “GOD, nobody understands me.” GOD answers back, “I don’t want them to. You are just looking for a shoulder to cry on, and I want you to cry on MY shoulder.” Some of you are in that desert place right now. Others of you are beginning to come out of the desert. You’ve been with GOD. You are talking to GOD, and GOD is talking to you. You’re meeting GOD’S terms. You’ve found that place in GOD where you are unmovable and unshakable. You’re not up and down in your Christian walk. You’ve come face to face with

GOD and with reality. You’ve learned the lessons of the desert well. You know how to pray, and you know how to take hold of HIS promises. You know who you are, and you know who GOD is. You don’t need human reassurance, because you’ve heard from GOD HIMSELF. You’re not hearing second hand, but you are talking to GOD directly, and HE is talking back.

“Arise and go down to the desert. I have something for you in the desert: perplexities, disappointments, heartaches, reverses.”<sup>30</sup> You can be in the desert physically, you can be there mentally, or you can be there spiritually. But GOD is dealing with your heart in that desert place.

Why, Philip, why are you going to the desert? “Because there is a man there who is going to turn a kingdom and a nation unto GOD.” GOD does not put you in a place of suffering because HE is displeased with you. GOD only allows the choicest to suffer. Suffering is not for run-of-the-mill people, because GOD doesn’t bother to grind anything but good wheat.<sup>31</sup>

You ask, “How come others have had it so easy and I’ve had it so hard?” They had it easy because GOD isn’t asking them to stand like an oak tree. “Why is it that so-and-so has so much in material goods?” It is because that’s all GOD has for them. GOD can’t trust them with suffering. HE can’t put any fire under them or they would burn up. GOD doesn’t waste HIS furnace of affliction. If there isn’t gold in your soul, GOD wouldn’t waste the furnace on you. If there isn’t something in you that will come forth with divine life, GOD will not send a trial or a tribulation your way. The trials and tribulations are for the saints of GOD that carry HIS WORD to humanity. The badge of Christian achievement is when that persecution that came upon JESUS, comes upon you.

Everyone loves to be patted on the back and hear people say good things about them. They glow like a neon light bulb. They love for people to love them and to think well of them. They don’t like to hear

Dear Pastor Tony,

## Arkansas

To my Pastor and friend,

I just finished reading again your message "Desert Warriors." I was looking through some copies of messages and re-read it. Thank you, thank you, thank you, thank you!!! Thank you most of all for sharing what God gives you to me and the world.

There were several times, over the years that stood out to me as 'desert' experiences in my Christian life. At the time I couldn't understand why God was allowing things to happen to me. It was only after being in that solitary place with God, that God could give me the understanding.

After my children were taken, I was again in that desert place. I couldn't sleep, I didn't want to eat, people couldn't comfort me, I wasn't hearing from God, I just wanted to die. I kept crying out to God, there were many middle of the night crying sessions. The only thing that kept me from total devastation was the Word of God, God's Holy Spirit, and His strength. When I'd finally drift off to sleep crying, worrying about them, etc., I'd awake again and my only ref-

uge and comfort was God's Word.

Eventually, I guess God got tired of my 'whining.' One night while once again crying and praying, God spoke to my heart and rebuked me. He told me that He knew what I was feeling; He had already gone through it. Not only was He separated from His Son but He sent His Son to die for my sons along with everyone else's sons. He told me to bring it up to Him and fully trust Him and He would take care of it. I instantly felt such a relief. I had been fretting, constantly only thinking of my circumstance rather than completely leaving it with God. It probably sounds pretty simple, things you've taught me for years, but now the real test was here. I'm not saying it was a piece of cake going through this trial, but after the Lord rebuked me I definitely felt at peace. I could now stay focused on the Lord and just realize that God is always in control. For whatever reason, God was allowing this to happen and it was going to turn to His Glory.

In your message you said, "God will take you out to that desert place where

people say, "Stay away from him. He's a heretic; he's in false doctrine." But what does GOD say... "Beware, son, when all men speak well of you. That is no badge of distinction. You are not on GOD'S record of good behavior when everyone is saying good things about you. But when they revile you and persecute you and say all manner of evil against you falsely for MY name's sake, rejoice and be exceedingly glad and dance for joy for great is your reward in Heaven."<sup>32</sup> So it should be music to your ears when men speak evil of you because of the name of JESUS.

GOD is looking for some Moseses, and some John the Baptists, and some Josephs, and some Deborahs, and some Samuels, because the world is in darkness and needs to have the Light of life delivered to them. HE wants those men and women to come out of the wilderness who have met GOD in those secret places, in the lonely hours, those heart-wrenching hours when you can't sleep and you have to pray, those only-known-to-GOD hours when the only moisture is the tears that run like rivers from your eyes as you cry out to GOD, "GOD, see me through this trial; help me make it through another day. stand now why YOU'VE let these things happen and YOU didn't send any rain into the desert place of loneliness, despair, rejection, privation, and misunderstanding, for it was YOU that brought me there."

You didn't understand at first; you said, "Why, what have I done? Where have I failed GOD? Why hasn't GOD opened up the door? Why am I in this situation?" You are there because GOD is preparing a man or a woman to take a message of salvation, love, unfailing mercy and grace to humanity. GOD will sustain you and you're going to embrace this desert experience. And you are going to thank GOD for it. The sweetest hour that you're ever going to know is when GOD comes down in that desert place, and right before you, is that burning bush in that lonely, solitary place. When you're homesick and weary, then suddenly the ANGEL of GOD appears and you start to thank GOD for this lonely windswept mountain. Then GOD will lead you in HIS SPIRIT to touch the hearts of men and women with HIS mighty, supernatural deliverance.

Get started now by saying this prayer to GOD:
