Dearest partners in Christ,



Study finds prayer by others helps patients

KANSAS CITY, Mo.- More than faith, it may be fact: Ill patients fare better when people pray for them, even when they're unaware that they're the subject of prayers, and even when they don't know the people doing the praying.

So says a study conducted by researchers at Kansas City's Mid-America Heart Institute at Saint Luke's Hospital and published Monday in The Archives of Internal Medicine. The study, one of the largest of its kind, offers the most compelling evidence yet linking improved health to what is known as off-site or "remote intercessory prayer."

"This is very significant," said physician Harold G. Koenig, an associate professor of psychiatry and medicine at Duke University School of Medicine who has conducted numerous studies on the effect of spirituality on health. "But I think it is going to be highly controversial. I'm not sure how many doctors are going to embrace this."

The research, conducted approximately a year ago and led by Ph.D. heart researcher William Harris, involved 990 heart patients admitted to the St. Luke's Hospital coronary care unit. All the patients in the study suffered a range of "serious life-threatening cardiac conditions" from heart attacks to

severe coronary heart disease to congestive heart failure.

Neither the patients nor their physicians were aware of the study or that any patients were being prayed for. The prayers were conducted away from the hospital. Members of the prayer groups were told nothing about the individuals for whom they prayed other than their first names and that they were ill. Each patient was made the subject of prayer for 28 days, starting one day after their admittance to the coronary care unit.

The conclusion: "The patients who were prayed for," said Harris, "just did better." By better, he said, "I mean everything that word means."

A statement of the miraculous healing observed by Dr. Jovovich

Back home in Yugoslavia and in Russia, I was a medical doctor in surgery from 1974. In U.S., I was licensed in the state of Florida in 1987 as Doctor of Medicine. In 1984 I passed California Medical Board, FLEX, and was given the license to practice medicine in the state of California.

The person whom I am writing about, Liam Hamilton, I shared a cell in Federal prison with for the last year (from 1995-1996). He suffered chronic hepatitis for the last several years. On last examination and biopsy of the liver, he was diagnosed to have cirrhosis of the liver. In the last two months he started bleeding externally, which is not uncommon for this kind of disease. The bleeding got worse as time progressed, to the point that he started losing over a liter of blood daily. In the given day he lost over two liters of blood, and practically could not move. Due to chronic blood loss during so many days he was not able to survive without surgical emergency intervention. Due to circumstances we were in, there was not hope that he was going to get emergency intervention. I was gravely concerned that he wouldn't survive through the night, so I went to inform Pastor Alamo, who came from his cell into Liam's and my cell where Liam lay on his cot dying. Pastor Alamo began talking to Liam about Jesus Christ, how Jesus is the only Saviour, Healer, and Deliverer, and told him he must pray to Jesus if he wants to be healed. Pastor Alamo told him if he didn't ask Jesus to heal him that he would die that night or sometime in the morning. After that, Pastor Alamo laid his hand over Liam, and started praying for him. I got scared and left the room. Pastor Alamo was praying for guite a while, and when he got out of the room he told me that Liam was healed of his bleeding problem and would be saved and healed of his hepatitis if he does not reject Jesus.

The following morning, the seemingly dying person was alive and well. The bleeding was completely stopped, he was in good spirit, you could see life in his eyes again.

To me as a medical doctor, it was a miracle that you usually hear from different people, but never see with your own eyes. This time, and for the first time, I saw it and witnessed it, but I cannot explain it! There is no medical explanation for it! Miraculous event happened from Pastor Alamo's hand touch and his prayers!

This extraordinary event made me convert. I began believing in Jesus Christ, and Pastor Alamo's godly power. Pastor Alamo's family was so kind to send me the Bible, so now I read and pray every day.

Pastor Alamo, thank you for saving human life through the power of prayer to Jesus who obviously is God! That is a wonderful deed!

of each individual pastor were distributed, to be fixed at their respective churches.



A vision from Satan or the Lord? Continued from page 1

In the first commandment God disallows our worship or concentration on any graven image: "Thou shalt have no other gods before me. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in Heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God" (Exod. 20:3-5). Jesus said this is the most important commandment of them all (Matt. 22:37-38).

The Word of God is our only weapon, defense, safeguard against Satan's deceptive dreams and visions, which he sends in hope that he might get us to break the first commandment and take any of our mind, heart, soul, and strength away from Jesus. The Lord God demands ALL or nothing at all. God

Another sure way to know whether your dream or vision is of God or the devil is to speak to it as though you are praying to God: "Jesus, is this You giving me this vision? Are you Jesus the Son of the living God who died on the cross at Calvary and SHED YOUR PRECIOUS BLOOD to forgive all my former sins so that I might be saved?"

When you say "the blood of Jesus," Satan will tremble and flee because it was the blood of Jesus that cut you loose from Satan, allowing you to sinlessly serve the Lord. 11 The Apostle James stated that we will all do well if we believe in God. He added, "The devils also believe, and tremble" (Jas. 2:19). Satan hates the blood of Jesus and the very name of Jesus, as well. Jesus and His blood defeated Satan on the cross of Calvary. 12 It was at the cross at Calvary where the fountain of Jesus' blood was produced at His death so that everyone in all ages could come and wash their filthy sins

away in Christ's perfect, sinless blood.¹³ Sins cannot be removed from our souls any other way.¹⁴ When our sins are washed away, we then can be saved. Christ will enter us and we will be given His power to keep His commandments.¹⁵ When we keep His commandments, we are able to receive the Comforter, which is the baptism with the Holy Spirit whereby the fullness of God with Christ His Father by the Spirit enters us.¹⁶ Satan hates this entire process. He trembles and flees from everyone who reminds him of it.

There is great power in the name and the blood of Jesus. The greatest of all defenses against Satan is Jesus' Word, if we but do what it says. ¹⁷ It is through the power of Christ's blood, which takes away all of our former sins, as well as His Spirit living in us with His Father that we gain His lifegiving Spirit of immortality. ¹⁸ His Word gives us the defense for retaining our immortal life and chases away every demon in Hell, including the devil himself and any of his dreams or visions. ¹⁹

Satan cannot stand before the blood of Jesus, the name of Jesus, or the Word of God.²⁰ We cannot stand before Jesus or His Father in prayer if we are not first covered in the blood of Jesus.²¹ The blood of Jesus is our standing before God. Through the blood of Jesus we are able to approach the throne of God boldly, because through our receiving Christ's blood as our atonement for sins, a door is made for us in the wall of partition between God and us.²² We are now able to enter through the door in the wall and bring our petitions before God. After our soul has been cleansed by the blood of Jesus, God will see the blood. His wrath will pass over us as it did in the days of Moses in Egypt. When God saw

the blood on the door posts and lintels of the houses of the Jews and Egyptians in those days, His wrath passed over those houses, who had acknowledged the symbolic meaning of the blood of Jesus.²³ The firstborn of every family was killed who did not acknowledge the blood.

Again, Satan hates the blood of Jesus both because it takes God's wrath away from us and because we become friends with God rather than enemies of God.²⁴ God becomes our friend, rather than our enemy, because once we have accepted the blood of His only begotten Son for the atonement of our sins, it causes God's wrath to go away.25 God's Word tells us there is no other atonement for our sins but the blood of Jesus.26 However, if we begin transgressing God's Word, His law, after we are washed in the blood of Jesus, sin again will appear on our souls, the door to Heaven will be closed, and the wrath of God will be upon us even worse than it was before we were cleansed.²⁷ Nothing but misery will be the fruit of those who have done or will do such an evil thing.

When you see any vision, whether it be of God or the devil, the Word of God tells us, "Believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God" (I John 4:1). It is a commandment from God to challenge all visions and dreams that we may know which vision or dream is from God or which is from the devil. God doesn't mind at all if we challenge visions that come from Him. The way we are to test these visions to see if they are true or from Satan is to say to the vision loudly, with full confidence, "The blood of Jesus is against thee, Satan!" If it is a vision from Satan meant to deceive vou, it will immediately vanish. If the vision or the dream is of the Lord, it will not vanish, but will stay, and if the vision or dream answers you back saying, "Yes, I am the Lord Jesus Christ who died on the cross and shed My sinless blood so that your former sins no longer exist," you are seeing a

Witnessing responses from Evie Arauz

As we were walking down the street we saw three elderly people sitting a few feet from each other, begging for money. The first lady looked like she was in her late 80's. I knelt down and started witnessing to her. As I was talking to her about salvation I looked into her eyes, and could tell that she was blind in one eye, and could barely see out of the other. I led her through the sinners' prayer, and the Spirit came down powerfully as we raised our hands and praised and thanked the Lord for her salvation. When I began to pray for her healing, she was weeping and said that she could feel the power of God.

I went to the next elderly lady, knelt down, witnessed to her, and prayed her through. She was very much at peace afterwards.

A few feet down from her there was an elderly blind man. After I witnessed to him he said that he wanted to accept Christ as his Savior. I led him through the

vision from the Lord and hearing His voice. You should then quickly receive what the Lord is telling you and seek Him for the meaning of the vision. You will bow down quickly before this vision, for this vision is from the Lord.

For two thousand years, Satan has used visions of poor Mary to deceive souls so that they might be destroyed eternally. The Lord tells us that anyone who adds to or takes away from the Word of the Lord shall be destroyed: "God shall take away his part out of the book of life" (Rev. 22:19). There is no place in the Bible where we are told to worship anyone other than God Almighty, who is the same as Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit, 28 but there are many places in the Bible that tell us we are to "worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve" (Matt. 4:10). 29

Millions of people have been delivered from this delusion. When they have been delivered, they always break their statues of Mary and of all others. The first commandment tells us that God despises statues or pictures, even those of Himself.³⁰ There are testimonies in Mexico, Central and South America, and elsewhere of huge bonfires built to burn the statues of such images. This happens when people in the pagan religions accept the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Savior through Christ's blood and obey His Word, the first commandment. People in India are condemned for worshipping cows, other animals, insects, and bugs. We must worship the Creator, not His creation.³¹

All visions in the past, in the present, and in the future of Mary are no more than deceptions from the devil (Rev. 12:9). Praying to Mary infuriates Almighty God because it mocks and breaks the first and most important commandment.


