My dad was told that my mom was about to sell my two little brothers and I on the black market. The Lord brought us children back to the church just in time.

When we returned to the church, we had nothing. Pastor Alamo took all of us children to the mall and bought us everything we needed. He gave our family the biggest and most beautiful house on the block to live in. We went back to the best private Christian school. Once again, we had everything and more than we could ever ask for. It was all provided to us by THE LORD WHO LIVES IN PASTOR TONY ALAMO.

My older step-sister used to watch me sometimes and I had a lot of fun with her. She lived at the house with Pastor Tony. I can testify to the fact that she wanted to be there and was happy to be in the church. Then, in 2006, she had to move out and decided to go to her dad who was not in the church. Eventually, she was sent to Wellspring by the government, the same place

We had birthday parties, pool parties, and several times we went on field trips to the zoo, to water parks, and to the fair. We went out to restaurants. I am so thankful for my pastor and all he has done. I am thankful that I was born in this church and for the gift of salvation that you can have as well. As Pastor Tony Alamo said, "I'm praying that God will get a hold of some of you people to help us with the ministry and to help us to help others. God bless you."
